

DESIGN NOTICE
ELYSIAN STREET AND EAST STREET
CONSTRUCTION

Dear Property Owner/Resident,

The City of St. Thomas is excited to announce that we are starting the design of Elysian Street from St. George Street to Penwarden Street and East Street from Elysian Street to the North limit.

Project scope will include replacement of watermain, sewers, sidewalk, and roadway. Construction is expected to take place in 2024 subject to council approval.

The proposed design uses a Complete Streets approach to improve and enhance accessibility for all road users including transit, vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians of all ages and abilities. The design will create space for a grass boulevard and a wider sidewalk on one side of the street instead of two narrow curb faced sidewalks to improve pedestrian safety and meet accessibility standards.

A Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held before construction begins to give you an opportunity to see proposed plans and speak to City staff about the project. More information about the PIC will be communicated in early 2024.
