



DOWNTOWN ST. THOMAS HERITAGE AREA STUDY – COMMUNITY CONSULTATION MEETING

The City of St. Thomas has retained Stantec Consulting Ltd. to conduct an Area Study in support of a potential Heritage Conservation District within the downtown. The area being examined is shown on the Key Map below. The Area Study will identify and evaluate heritage buildings and landscapes within the downtown area to determine overall heritage character of the area. The goal of the study is to determine whether this area, or any portion of it, warrants consideration as a candidate area for Heritage Conservation District designation under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*.
