

Update from City Council meeting - April 4, 2022

City Council approved the implementation of the Homelessness Prevention Program.

City Council received a report regarding options for the upcoming Waste Management Services RFP. A discussion took place regarding potential changes to the services that would be provided.

City Council received a report regarding Off-Street Recreational Trail Maintenance Standards. A discussion took place regarding the take-in, take-out for garbage.

City Council received a report regarding the 2022 Municipal Election. Residents are encouraged to check www.voterlookup.ca to ensure they are on the voters list.

City Council rescinded the Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination Policy and Procedure. This will not apply to the Police Service or Valleyview Home since they are under different policies.

City Council approved the Mural and Publicly Accessible Art Program and authorized a mural be painted on 614 Talbot Street. A rendering of the mural can be seen below.

City Council proclaimed August 8th to 14th as Pride Week and authorized the Pride flag be flown at City Hall and that Jumbo be lit in rainbow colours for the week.

Public Notice was provided regarding a Capital Budget Unbudgeted Expense - New Road Plow and a New Sidewalk Plow. Administration intends to introduce a report at the April 11, 2022 Council meeting requesting the approval of an unbudgeted expenditure for the purchase of a new road plow and new sidewalk plow.

Public Notice was provided regarding a Capital Budget Adjustment - New Airport Snow Plow. Administration intends to introduce a report at the April 11, 2022 Council meeting requesting approval of an expenditure increase related to the purchase of a new Airport Sone Plow.

Public Notice was provided regarding Administrative Fees - Lot Maintenance By-Law - Environmental Services. Administration intends to introduce the inclusion of administrative fees as part of the lot maintenance by-law. This will be considered at the April 11, 2022 Council meeting.
