



## Update from City Council meeting - May 9, 2022

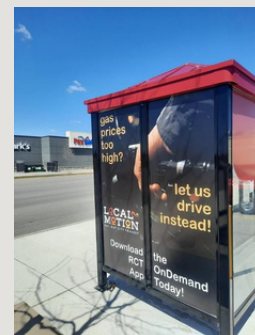
A deputation was presented by Jim Hogan, President and CEO, Entegrus requesting approval of a Shareholder's waiver regarding the proposed sale of the fibre business.

City Council received a report regarding Traffic Control - Moore Street/McIntyre Street/Alma College Square Entrance. Council voted to accept scenario 2 as seen below.



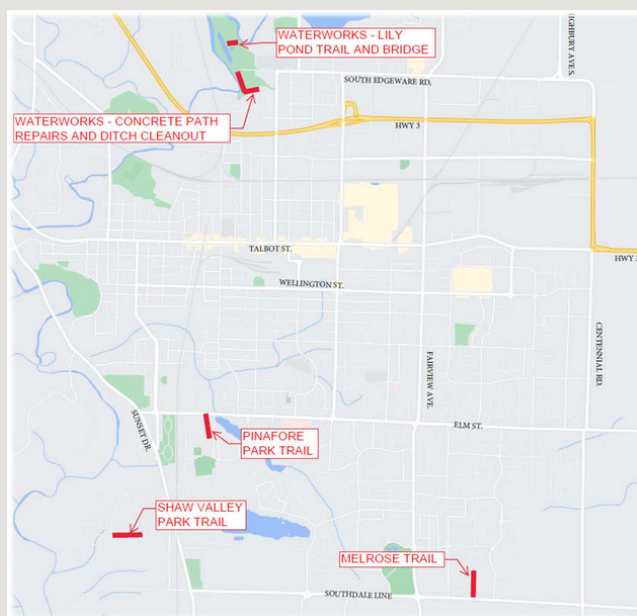
City Council approved the extension of the Transit Advertising Program with VanPelt's.
