
<u>ADJOURNMENT</u>



PRESCRIBED SIGNS UNDER THE HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT

- iii) for on street purposes, where parallel parking conditions exist, spaces should be no less than 7000 mm long.
- iv) a vertical clearance of 2750 mm must be maintained below overhead structures, such as canopies or signs, building overhangs, and on roadways that provide access to barrier-free entrances to buildings.
- vi) be placed so sidewalks, paths, etc., will be accessible to persons with disabilities whether via ramps, depressed curbs, or other appropriate means
- vii) placed with sufficient clearance around the vehicle, in terms of other vehicles, or obstacles such as light standards, waste receptacles, etc.;
- viii) identified by a prescribed sign (see Appendix B) located upright on a post, no less than 1500 mm above ground level. Painting the universal symbol of wheelchair access on the payement is not considered a prescribed sign.
