

HIGHLIGHTS OF CITY COUNCIL MEETING: MAY 8, 2023

BURWELL PARK

Council has awarded a tender in the amount of \$435,415 (excluding HST) to Ro-Buck Contracting Ltd for the basketball and pickleball courts at Burwell Park.

The project has a proposed start date of May 2023 and is anticipated to conclude in August 2023. The project will include two basketball courts, with professional-style backboards and nets, and four pickleball courts. All courts will be finished with an acrylic coating and fencing.



FOUR-WAY STOP



Council has asked for a temporary four-way stop at the intersections of Centre Street & Princess Avenue and Centre Street & Elgin Street. The four-way stops will be in place for the remainder of the Talbot Street stage 1 construction.

COUNCIL REMUNERATION

Council has asked for a report back on Council Remuneration (by-law 66-2009) to look at mileage for out of town committees/boards as well as extra remuneration for work performed while serving as Chair or Vice-Chair on outside boards. The report will examine what is currently offered and what other communities are providing.
