#### CITY RESPONSE TO THE HOUSING AFFORDABILITY TASK FORCE'S RECOMMENDATION

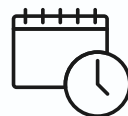
Council endorsed the top five Task Force recommendations being proposed by senior administration and direct staff to submit a response before the October 16th deadline.
