2024 CAPITAL AND OPERATING BUDGET APPROVAL

Council adopted the estimated 2024 gross expenditures of \$51,749,319 for Capital and \$155,193,621 for Operating which means a total of 2.95% increase from 2023.

Council adopted the estimated 2024 non-tax revenues of \$138,241,737 and tax levy of \$68,816,203, to support these gross expenditures.

Council adopted the current operating and capital estimates, required for 2024 as outlined in the 2024 Operating and Capital Budget documents.

Council authorized the Director of Finance and City Treasurer to draft a by-law that sets the 2024 tax rates based upon a levy of \$68,816,203 and provides for the 2024 property tax policies required by the Ministry of Finance.
