REQUEST FOR HERITAGE ALTERATION PERMITS:

Council received a Heritage Alteration Permit request for 831 Talbot Street as it relates to the installation of a new sign and that it not be internally illuminated.

BILL MARTYN PARKWAY RECONSTRUCTION

Council received and authorized the request to award \$1413,812.49 towards the Bill Martyn Parkway Reconstruction project. This project brings servicing to the proposed Animal Services Centre and adjacent development lands.

ELYSIAN STREET RECONSTRUCTION

Council received and authorized the request to award \$2,194,182 towards the Elysian Street Reconstruction project, and endorsed the conversion of Pearl Street from one-way traffic to two-way traffic.
