CITY OF ST. THOMAS BY-LAW NO. 66-94

A by-law respecting the licensing of pawn brokers.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ST. THOMAS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. No person shall carry on the business of a pawn broker within the City of St. Thomas unless he first obtains a license therefor from the Corporation.
- 2. The fee for the license required by Section 1 shall be \$100.00 per year or for any part thereof.
- 3. Every pawn broker shall give to the Corporation security satisfactory to the Treasurer in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the due observance by the pawn broker of the Pawn Broker's Act, R.S.O. 1990 and all amendments thereto.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offense.
- 5. By-Law 124-87 is repealed.
