Rules

- For public skating, a maximum capacity of 175 skaters is permitted. Skates are required when on the ice (no footwear).
- CSA approved hockey helmets are mandatory for all participants 12 and under.
 - Face cages strongly recommended.
- No figure skating maneuvers, racing, or speedskating permitted.
- No toboggans, sleds or strollers on the ice surface
- Parents are not allowed to skate around carrying a child. This is an unsafe practice.
- No food or drink, gum chewing or cell phone use on the ice
- Hockey stick, pucks, and balls are not allowed during adult leisure skate or parent & tot skate times (Join us for Little Players or Shinny for stick and puck play)
- Be respectful of other skaters and employees
