Update Report

October/November 2017

Activities:

- 1) I attended the "Discovery Week" fall retreat in Stratford on Oct 25th. We were provided with feedback from the University and of course the students on how the events went that week. We were also provided with an opportunity to suggest changes and to network with other communities. Two communities provided a presentation highlighting the events they provided for their students. Lots of good ideas shared. Western will be providing us with the students slide presentation. I will arrange to show this at a future partnership meeting.
- 2) Dr. Elsie Osagie will be participating in the New Physician Orientation Program on Dec. 5th in preparation for her taking over her new position from Dr. Green.
